



**NOTICE OF MOTIONS: CONFERRAL OF HONORARY MEMBERSHIP VOTES AT THE
NOVEMBER 3rd, 2022, ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING
SPORT MEDICINE COUNCIL OF BRITISH COLUMBIA**

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 SportMedBC's Bylaws 2.3-2.5 (below) provide for conferral of honorary membership on individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the organization. The Board selects such individuals for consideration by the voting members.
- 1.2 Conferral of honorary membership requires a 75 per cent approving vote of voting members present at the annual meeting, after a minimum of 15 days' notice has been provided to the membership.

2.0 NOTICE OF MOTION #1: CONFERRAL OF HONORARY MEMBERSHIP ON LYNN KANUKA

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SPORTMEDBC that honorary membership be conferred by the membership on Mrs. Lynn Kanuka. Conferral requires approval by 75 per cent of members attending the annual meeting.

Lynn Kanuka is a Canadian Olympic bronze medalist at the 1984 Olympics in the 3000 m. She joined the SportMedBC team in the mid 1990's to create and support the Vancouver Sun RunWalk clinics which became the InTraining clinics. Lynn also created the Aboriginal RunWalk program in which she was also involved and is still involved since it moved to ISPARC. Coach Lynn has been the official SportMedBC InTraining Coach until 2021.

2.3 Honorary membership: Individuals may become honorary members if they have made outstanding contributions to the Society over several years and have been selected by the Board and named as honorary members by voting members as set out in bylaw 2.4. Honorary membership is a non-voting class.

2.4 The conferral of honorary membership on an individual must be approved by at least 75 per cent of the voting members present at a general meeting. Notice of motion for such a vote must be given to the membership at least 15 days before the meeting.

2.5 The call for nominations for honorary membership shall be made at least once per year by the Society.
